SUBJECT: LA County Public Health Order Masking Update and Cal/OSHA Regulations

With fewer COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations, Los Angeles County is easing [masking requirements](#) in certain settings.

At the workplace, we must continue to comply with Cal/OSHA regulations as summarized below:

For Employees	For Public Persons
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• *Masks are strongly recommended for all employees indoors regardless of vaccination status.• Not fully vaccinated employees must wear *masks indoors and in shared vehicles.• **Fully vaccinated employees may remove their masks indoors only if they completed and submitted the vaccination self-attestation form (see attached).	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Masks are strongly recommended for all public persons indoors regardless of vaccination status.

**Mask means surgical mask, a medical procedure mask, a respirator worn voluntarily, or a tightly woven fabric or non-woven material of at least two layers.*

***You are considered fully vaccinated two weeks after completing the primary vaccination for a single dose COVID19 vaccine or two weeks after receiving the second dose of any combination of two dose COVID19 vaccine.*

*Masks are required to be worn by everyone regardless of vaccination status, in the following settings:

- Public Transit and Transportation Hubs (Buses, bus terminal, airport, or any other area that provides public transport).
- Indoors in childcare facilities through March 11, 2022.
- Healthcare settings including long-term care facilities and adult and senior care facilities.
- Local correctional facilities and detention centers.
- Homeless shelter, emergency shelters, and cooling and hearing centers.

As we anticipate changes in masking requirements, we will continue to support those who choose to wear a mask and encourage proactive steps to care for the health of our workplace and community. We will continue to monitor changes to safety regulations and update everyone. Thank you for your continued cooperation.
