SUBJECT: Update on LA County Quarantine Order and Isolation Order

As we have all noted in the first three days of 2022, COVID19 transmission is surging in the County, State, and Nation. While we enjoyed several months of declining or stabilizing transmission rates, it's time for all of us to take extra precautions to ensure the ongoing safety of the workplace and the Torrance community.

UPDATED QUARANTINE AND ISOLATION ORDERS

Attached with this memo are the most recent LA County Health Officer Orders related to quarantine and isolation. Please read these orders carefully, as they detail who is required to follow the order, what you are required to do to comply with the order, and resources to support you if you are required to quarantine or isolate.

REMINDERS FOR WORKPLACE SAFETY

- **Wear a cloth face covering** at all times.
- **Adhere to social (physical) distancing** guidelines while in the office or in the field by maintaining at least six (6) feet of physical distance from the public and coworkers.
- **Wash hands frequently** with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or using hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- **Clean and disinfect frequently** touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipes.

COVID TESTING SITES

Los Angeles County continues to strongly encourage residents who are interested in being tested to first contact their Primary Care Provider or Healthcare Center about receiving a test at their facility. Those who do not have access to a Primary Care Provider or are unable to contact them may receive free testing available from the State or County. To find a location near you, please visit:
