### **OPEN**

- Grocery Stores, Supermarkets, Certified Farmers' Markets (50% indoor capacity, except stand-alone grocery stores encouraged to limit 50% indoor capacity, and certified farmer's markets encouraged to limit 50% outdoor capacity.)
- Flea Markets, Swap Meets
- Convenience Stores, Wholesale Clubs and Pharmacies
- Hardware, Building, Home Appliance, and Pool Supply Stores
- Indoor Malls and Shopping Centers (50% indoor capacity)
- Non-Essential Businesses and Lower-Risk Retail Stores (Clothing, Toy, Furniture, Jewelry, Bookstores) (50% indoor capacity)
- Car Dealerships, Car Washes, and Car Repair Facilities
- Pet Food Stores, Boarding/Grooming Facilities, and Veterinary Clinics
- Therapeutic and Peer Support Groups
- Manufacturing and Warehousing Facilities
- Personal Care Establishments (75% indoor capacity)
- Places of Worship (50% indoor capacity)
- Vehicle-Based Parades and Drive-in Movie Theaters
- Gyms and Fitness Centers (50% indoor capacity)
- Restaurants and Cafés (50% indoor capacity or 200 people whichever is less.)
- Breweries, and Wineries - with no meal service (indoor 50% or 200 people whichever is less. Other modifications apply.)
- Movie Theaters (50% indoor capacity or 200 people, reserved seating with 6 feet of distance in all directions.)
- Museums, Galleries, Zoos, and Aquariums (75% indoor capacity)
- Youth/Adult Recreational Sports (by current Tier of County)
- Beaches, Parks, Public Trails
- Campgrounds, RV Parks, and Outdoor Recreation
- Day Camps and Child Care Centers
- Music, Film, and Television Production
- Hotels, Lodging, and Short Term Rentals
- Amusement Parks (35% capacity)
- Outdoor Sports and Live Performances (67% capacity)
- Community Sporting Events
- Family Entertainment Centers and Arcades (50% indoor capacity)
- Indoor Playgrounds
- Live Performance Theaters
- Bowling Alleys
- Libraries (for limited in-person browsing, public internet access.)
- Miniature Golf, Batting Cages and Outdoor Equipment Rental
- Bars and Craft Distilleries (25% indoor capacity or 100 people)

### **HEALTHCARE SERVICES**

- Clinics, Hospitals, Dental Clinics, Physical Therapy and Chiropractic Offices, Optometrists, Mental or Behavioral Health Providers, and other Healthcare Settings

### **CLOSED**

- Lounges and Nightclubs
- Festivals
- Hot Tubs, Steam Rooms, and Saunas (except at a residence)
