CHANGES TO THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER

- **Restaurants, Breweries, Brewpubs, and Wineries are only allowed to offer take-out, drive-thru, and delivery services. Wineries and breweries may continue their retail operations adhering to current protocols. In-person dining will not be allowed, until further notice by LA County Public Health Order, and must close from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Businesses can offer pick-up and delivery services outside of these hours, as permitted.**
- **Non-essential businesses, including retail stores, offices, and personal care services must close from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Businesses can offer pick-up and delivery services outside of these hours, as permitted. Personal care services provided by appointment only with masks worn at all times.**
- **Batting cages limited to 50% maximum outdoor capacity.**

OPEN

OPEN FOR INDOOR/OUTDOOR USE

- Grocery Stores, Supermarkets, Certified Farmers' Markets
- Convenience Stores, Wholesale Clubs and Pharmacies
- Hardware, Building, Home Appliance, and Pool Supply Stores
- Malls and Indoor Shopping Centers (Max. 25% indoor occupancy)
- Lower Risk Retail Stores (Clothing, Toy, Furniture, Jewelry) *
- Hair Salons, Barbershops, Nail Salons, Tanning Salons, Massage, Cosmetology, Other Personal Care Services (by appointment only) *
- Car Dealerships, Car Washes, and Car Repair Facilities
- Flea Markets, Swap Meets, and Drive-In Movie Theaters
- Manufacturing and Warehousing Facilities
- Pet Food Stores, Boarding/Grooming Facilities, and Veterinary Clinics
- Therapeutic and Peer Support Groups (fewer than 15 people)

DELIVERY, PICK-UP, OR OUTDOOR SERVICES

- Restaurants and Cafés for Delivery, Drive-Thru, and Carry-Out only. (No in-person dining is allowed, until further notice by LA County Public Health Order. Breweries and Wineries may continue their retail operations. Must close from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.) *

HEALTHCARE SERVICES

- Clinics, Hospitals, Dental Clinics, Physical Therapy and Chiropractic Offices, Optometrists, Mental or Behavioral Health Providers, and other Healthcare Settings

RECREATION, ENTERTAINMENT, TRAVEL & LEARNING

- Beaches, Parks, Public Trails, Community Gardens, Outdoor Playgrounds, Golf Courses, Pickleball, Tennis, Bocce Courts, and Model Airplane Areas
- Outdoor Public Pools and Outdoor Pools in Multi-Unit Residential Housing (e.g., Apartments, Condominiums, and HOAs)
- Campgrounds, RV Parks, and Outdoor Recreation (incl. Equip Rentals)
- Day Camps and Child Care Centers
- Music, Film, and Television Production
- Hotels, Lodging, and Short Term Rentals
- Vehicle-Based Parades and Drive-in Movie Theaters
- Libraries

OUTDOOR SERVICES OR ACTIVITIES ONLY

- Gyms/Fitness Centers (incl. in Multi-unit Residential Housing)
- Outdoor Batting Cages (Limited to 50% maximum outdoor capacity)
- Museums, Galleries, Zoos, and Aquariums
- Places of Worship including Weddings/Funerals (Recorded and live-streamed services without an audience are also allowed.)
- Youth Sports Leagues (Only outdoor youth sports activities that allow for appropriate physical distancing are allowed.)

*** Businesses MUST CLOSE from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Businesses can offer pick-up and delivery services outside of these hours, as permitted.**

CLOSED

- Arcades, Bowling Alleys, and Movie Theaters
- Bars and Craft Distilleries (except for Retail Sales)
- Basketball and Volleyball Courts
- Family Entertainment Centers are closed for all indoor operations (Only Outdoor Batting Cages, Go Karts, and Mini Golf can be open)
- Festivals, Live Performance Theaters and Concert Venues
- Hot Tubs, Jacuzzis, and Spa Pools (if not at a residence)
- Lounges and Nightclubs
- Stadiums and Arenas (Closed to the Public)
- Theme/Amusement Parks (including Water Parks and Splash Pads in these Parks)
