OPEN

OPEN FOR INDOOR/OUTDOOR USE

- Grocery Stores, Supermarkets, Certified Farmers' Markets
- Convenience Stores, Wholesale Clubs and Pharmacies
- Lower Risk Retail Stores (Clothing, Toy, Furniture, Jewelry)
- Hotels, Lodging and Short-Term Rentals
- Music, Film and Television Production
- Car Dealerships
- Car Washes
- Flea Markets, Swap Meets, and Drive-In Movie Theaters
- Manufacturing/Warehousing Facilities
- Pet Food Stores, Grooming Facilities, and Veterinary Clinics
- Therapeutic and Peer Support Groups (fewer than 15 people)
- Day Camps
- Hardware, Building, Home Appliance, and Pool Supply Stores
- Breweries, Brewpubs, and Wineries (*On site consumption and tastings are not allowed. Retail sales ONLY.*)

OPEN FOR HEALTHCARE SERVICES

- Clinics, Hospitals, Dental Clinics, Physical Therapy, Chiropractic Offices, Optometrists, Mental or Behavioral Health Providers, and other Healthcare Settings

OPEN FOR RECREATION

- Campgrounds, RV Parks and associated outdoor recreation
- Professional Sports without live audiences
- Swimming Pools and Splash Pads
- Parks (playgrounds are closed)
- Trails, Bike Paths, Beaches, and other open spaces
- Golf Courses
- Tennis and Pickleball Courts and Batting Cages
- Community Gardens

OPEN/OUTDOOR OPERATIONS RECOMMENDED

- Hair Salons and Barbershops (25% maximum indoor capacity)

OPEN ONLY FOR OUTDOOR OPERATIONS TAKE OUT, CURBSIDE PICKUP, AND DELIVERY

- Restaurants and Cafés
- Places of Worship (including Weddings/Funerals)
- Nails Salons, Tanning Salons, Cosmetology Services
- Massage Therapy
- Gyms and Fitness Facilities
- Zoos, Museums, and Galleries
- Libraries

CLOSED

- Indoor Malls (Stores with a normally accessible public entrance on the exterior may use curbside pickup. Interior portions of malls are closed.)
- Bowling Alleys, Arcades and Movie Theaters
- Bars, Brew Pubs, Pubs, Brewery/Winery *Tasting Rooms (ONLY retail sales are allowed see above)*
- Tattoo Parlors
- Lounges and Nightclubs, Cardrooms
- Non-Essential Office worksites
- Live Entertainment Theaters, Concert Venues, and Festivals
- Basketball and Volleyball Courts
- Indoor and outdoor playgrounds for children, except those located within a school or childcare center
- Hot tubs, Steams Rooms and Saunas not located on a residential property
- All events and gatherings, unless specifically allowed by the LA County Public Health Order
- Youth Sports Leagues
